Dress Code & Uniform Information

Our school uniform is a symbol used to identify our students as members of the student body. St. Francis Xavier students are to wear their uniforms with pride and dignity. Neatness is expected, along with all clothing being worn properly and in a manner within guidelines of school expectations. Please read carefully our uniform and dress requirements. All students must be in compliance with our uniform and dress code policy daily unless the day has been designated as a free dress, spirit day, or dress up day.

Any student who is not properly groomed and/or not properly attired may be:

- Prohibited from participation in the school day until the proper dress code or grooming policy is met
- Removed from or not allowed to be a part of the school related ceremony, event, or activity.

All students:

- Light blue polo or oxford style uniform shirts, long or short sleeved with school logo. Shirts must be buttoned and tucked in.
- Students must wear solid black or navy belts if the pants/shorts have loops.
- Jackets, sweaters, sweater vests, or school sweat shirts may be worn for inside use. Sweatpants may not be worn to school.
- No visible tattoos are allowed.
- Black, grey, or white tennis shoes are allowed.

Girls:

Grades K – 4th – Plaid jumpers, skirts, shorts, long pants...

Grades 5 – 8: Plaid skirts; Navy shorts or uniform pants. (No leggings or close fit non-uniform pants.)

Light polo shirts; tailored short/long sleeve cotton blouses with logo.

Mass Day Requirements: Plaid skirts or jumpers are required. No exception...

Artificial nails, only clear nail polish, earrings larger than a quarter, or make up may be worn.

Girls may wear navy or white tights during cold weather.

Headbands or bows must be navy, school plaid, or white.

Socks must be black, white, or navy.

Boys:

- Navy blue trousers or knee length shorts.
- On days of Mass, boys must wear long pants.
- Vests, sweatshirts, or sweaters may be worn on cooler days. Non-uniform jackets may not be worn.

Students may not change clothes after school Mass.
