SCIENCE

Experiment: How does a Leaf Breathe?

- Materials Needed
 - Large leaf (ACTIVE leaf- meaning one that is removed from the tree or plant not already on the ground)
 - Large bowl
 - Small rock

Step 1: Fill a large bowl with lukewarm water (glass or plastic)

Step 2: Find a large leaf (remove a leaf from a tree or plant and not off the ground)

Step 3: Place the leaf in the bowl of water and put a small rock on top of it so it is FULLY submerged under the water. Then place the bowl in a sunny spot.

Step 4: WAIT for a few hours!! (4 or 5 hours)

Step 5: Take a peek a few hours later. Record your observation. (small bubbles should form around the leaf) A leaf does not have lungs but it is a living organism just like we are!
