Vocabulary:

Parallel lines-two or more lines that always the same distance apart and will never cross.

Perpendicular lines-two lines that meet to form a right angle.

Polygon-two-dimensional closed figure made with three or more straight line segments that do not cross over each other.

Obtuse angle- an angle that measure more than 90 but less than 180

Right angle-an angle that looks like a square corner and measures 90

Acute angle-an angle with a measure less than 90

Average Speed-describe how far an object moves during a certain amount of time.

Noncontact Force- a force that acts at a distance.
