RE: 2026–2027 School Uniform and Dress Code Requirements

Dear Parents and Students,

The St. Francis Xavier Catholic School uniform is an important symbol of our school community. It identifies our students as members of the St. Francis Xavier Catholic School family and reflects our commitment to faith, academic excellence, school pride, and respect.

For the 2026–2027 school year, all **newly purchased uniforms** will feature the school's new logo and will be a white button-down or polo top. Students are expected to wear their uniforms neatly and in accordance with the Uniform and Dress Code Policy outlined in the **2026–2027 Parent/Student Handbook** (pp. 28–29). All students must comply with the uniform requirements each school day unless otherwise designated as a Free Dress Day, Spirit Day, or other approved special dress occasion.

Students who are not properly groomed or dressed according to school policy may be:

- Prohibited from participating in the school day until the dress code violation is corrected;
- Removed from or denied participation in school-related ceremonies, events, or activities.

All newly purchased uniforms will be white and will consist of the school's new official logo.

General Uniform Requirements for All Students:

- White Oxford-style uniform shirts with the school logo (long or short sleeves).
- Shirts must always be buttoned and tucked in.
- Students must wear solid black or navy belts when pants or shorts have belt loops.
- School-approved jackets, sweaters, sweater vests, or school sweatshirts may be worn indoors.
- Sweatpants are not permitted.
- Visible tattoos are not allowed.
- Shoes must be solid black or navy (dark blue).

Girls' Uniform Requirements:

Grades K–4

- Plaid jumpers, skirts, shorts, or long pants.

Grades 5–8

- Plaid skirts, navy shorts, or uniform pants.
- No leggings or tight-fitting non-uniform pants.
- White polo shirts or long-sleeved cotton blouses with school logo.

Additional requirements:

- Only clear nail polish may be worn.



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- Artificial nails and makeup are not permitted.
- Earrings may not be larger than a quarter.
- Navy or white tights may be worn during cold weather.
- Headbands and bows must be navy, white, or school plaid.
- Socks must be black, white, or navy.
- Shoes must be solid black or navy.

Boys' Uniform Requirements:

- Navy blue trousers or knee-length shorts.
- School-approved vests, sweatshirts, or sweaters may be worn during cooler weather.
- Non-uniform jackets are not permitted.
- Students may not change clothes after school Mass.

Mass Day Uniform Requirements:

All students are required to wear the designated **Mass-Ready Uniform**.

Girls

- White button-down blouse with school logo.
- Plaid skirt or jumper (required; no exceptions).
- Navy or white tights may be worn during cold weather.
- Headbands or bows must be navy, white, or school plaid.
- Socks must be black, white, or navy.
- Shoes must be solid black or navy.

Boys

- White cotton button-down collared shirt with school logo (required; no exceptions).
- Navy blue trousers.
- Blue or black tie.
- School-approved vest, sweatshirt, or sweater (logo or solid dark blue) may be worn during cooler weather.
- Non-uniform jackets are not permitted.
- Shoes must be solid black or navy.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping maintain the standards and traditions of St. Francis Xavier Catholic School. Your support ensures that all students present themselves in a manner that reflects the values and expectations of our school community.
